## THE FCA VALUES

Our objective is to have as many team Bible studies as possible. This happens through the partnership of local churches to help facilitate team Bible studies, team chaplain programs and provide character coaches. Coaches Bible studies have been very effective this year and will continue to grow. We hope to provide every coach and every athlete with a Bible and to increase the number of coaches and athletes going to FCA camps. We will be volunteer intensive by encouraging, equipping and empowering others.

#### What can you do?

- Pray pray for our staff and coaches; you can pray over a list of the Coaches who work at your school.

- 3. \$150 for camp scholarship
- 4. \$175 for team meal
- 5. \$300 for a Coaches scholarship (spouse)
